Junior Clubwoman of the Year - *Linda G. White Silver Wine Cooler*. The award is given annually to honor a Junior clubwoman who has given of her time, talents, interest, organizational efforts, and active participation to render outstanding service through the Federation. The judging is based on accomplishments during **the previous calendar year, January 1 to December 31**. This award is first judged on the District level.

Rules for Participation

1. Three copies of the entry must be sent by the club president to the District Junior Director or District Awards Chairman postmarked no later than **February 1** of each year. Entry may not exceed four pages (one being the cover).
2. The Junior Director or District Awards Chairman will have these judged by three General Clubwomen who live outside and preferably not adjacent to the district for which they serve as judges. The district award will be presented at the District Arts Festival.
3. Following this meeting, three (3) copies of the district winning award entry will be sent to GFWC-NC Director of Junior Clubs Angela Moss, postmarked no later than **March 1st**: For award contact information refer to the GFWC-NC Admin Book or 2020-2022 All Awards Contact List available from GFWC-NC Headquarters.
4. The three judges for selection of the GFWC-NC winner should be those serving as current or past state presidents of other organizations in North Carolina and/or Past Presidents or Directors of Juniors of GFWC-NC or of other states in the GFWC; with a least one being a member of the GFWC-NC.
5. A club may not enter the same member for more than one of the GFWC-NC Individual Awards in the same year.
6. Past winners of this award on the GFWC-NC level shall not be eligible to win the same award again.

Criteria:

Judging criteria will be based on activities for the previous calendar year only. The award is given annually to honor a Junior clubwoman who has given of her time, talents, interest, organizational efforts and active participation to render outstanding service through the Federation. Submit in detail the achievements and the nature of service of your candidate, noting the qualifications of your nominee and keeping in mind that the judging will be based on the following items:

- Contribution through Federation: 30-GFWC-NC, 25-District, 25-Local 80 Points
- Participation in Community Affairs (Church, political, other service organizations, civic, board positions, etc.....10 Points
- Cooperation with individuals and other club members..... 10 Points
- TOTAL100 Points

Note: Nominees will be judged only on the information you furnish.
